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This was a busy week at the Capitol for ACEC Kansas. Late last Friday, after the ACEC Kansas weekly legislative bulletin had already been sent, House leaders announced at a press conference that they had a new tax plan proposal. There were no copies available. Economic Lifelines sent an email that evening saying the new plan would take \$180 million annually from the T-Works program. Saturday, the Kansas Economic Progress Council sent an email saying the new plan took \$159.6 million from the T-Works program. It was impossible to be sure what the new plan did because no one had access to the actual language. Tuesday afternoon, finally, a copy of the bill (HB 2747) became available. Hearings were scheduled for Wednesday and Thursday, leaving virtually no time for analysis or to prepare testimony. The bill has several pieces, including the following:

- Contributions to the state highway fund would be frozen at 2013 levels in 2014 and 2015...meaning about \$350 million less than projected under T-Works.
- From 2016 to 2022, the plan would provide an extra \$50 million dollars a year, making the total amount contributed the same as current law.
- The state budget would be subject to a cap on spending increases of 2% in the future.
- State income tax levels would be cut.

Proponents of the bill claim this leaves T-Works fully funded while cutting income taxes. That is a perspective ACEC Kansas does not share.

ACEC Kansas testified in strong opposition to this bill yesterday, along with numerous other stakeholder groups from around the state. The problems are numerous. Taking funding in the short term and backloading it means KDOT cannot take advantage of current favorable market conditions on labor and material costs, bond ratings and interest rates, etc. T-Works projects will cost more if put off until later years. The likelihood of the \$50 million per year from 2016-2022 ever actually being repaid to the state highway fund is extremely small. As many of you know, the legislature has a long history of “borrowing” money from transportation and not repaying a dime. Those past promises were broken even though there was no ceiling on what the legislature could spend and budget...it will be infinitely harder to keep the promises of HB 2747 given that spending growth for the state will be capped at 2%.

There is no word yet on when the bill will be debated in the House Tax Committee. If the bill does indeed move forward, we'll have urgent messages sent to our members asking you to contact your legislators. In the meantime, Economic Lifelines has put together a very helpful schedule of legislator forums where you can visit with lawmakers and make your voice heard on HB 2747 and all other issues. HB 2429, dealing with procurement for the Board of Regents on privately funded projects, continues to await action on the House floor. It is likely to be considered sometime next week.

SB 301, which changes the expiration terms on appointments to the Kansas Board of Technical Professions, passed the Senate Federal and State Affairs Committee Thursday and looks likely to race through the full Senate without much objection.

Next week we'll see almost all the action switch from the committee rooms to the full chambers. Next Friday is "turnaround day", the day by which most bills have to be passed by the full

chamber in which they originated or be dead for the session. Once that deadline passes, we'll have a clearer picture of which pieces of legislation have traction and which do not.
