The legislature adjourned Thursday afternoon, marking what is known as “turnaround”. That is the point at which most bills must be successfully through their chamber of origin or be dead for the session. Both chambers adjourned late Thursday afternoon and will take a five day weekend, reconvening next Wednesday.

The week started very poorly for ACEC Kansas and other groups who care about infrastructure investment. We had previously reported on HB 2747, the House tax plan, which would divert over \$350 million away from T-Works over the next two fiscal years, then (in theory) repay that with an additional \$50 million per year for the following seven years. As we articulated last week, there are numerous reasons why that is a terrible idea. The House Tax Committee voted on the bill Monday and passed it out with a favorable recommendation to the full House. Before doing so, they made several high-impact amendments to the bill (none of which directly impacted T-Works), then took that new package and amended the entire thing into a Senate bill that had already passed the Senate and was awaiting action in the House. This is called a “gut-and-go” and is not an uncommon procedure. What it means in practical terms is this: if the House passes the bill, it can go straight to a conference committee instead of the full Senate, as the Senate already passed the bill (in its prior form).

This was a blow to our interests, as we had legitimate hopes of having the House Tax Committee vote it down. There is a silver lining, however. Due to the complexity of the amendments that were added to the bill before passage, legislative staff is still trying to sort out the full impact and fiscal cost of the bill. This has given ACEC Kansas and other stakeholder groups time to express our concern to legislative leaders. The Kansas Economic Progress Council reported Thursday evening that the bill may now be sent back to the House Tax Committee for more study instead of being put before the full House for consideration.

With this in mind, ***we urge ACEC Kansas members to continue to contact your State Representative!!!*** We sent out an action alert Tuesday with talking points. That action alert is attached to this email as well. Please urge your Representative to vote “no” on SB 177, and to oppose this or any other measure that changes the funding amounts **or** schedule for T-Works. The four day weekend the Legislature is taking provides a great opportunity to contact your State Representative at home.

Several other bills passed their chamber of origin and will move forward to committee action soon. These include SB 301 (changing duration of terms for Board of Technical Professions members), SR 1805 (encouraging local units of government to support “livable streets”), and HB 2429 (making permanent certain procurement options the Board of Regents can use on select projects).

Next week is likely to be slow, with committee action beginning Wednesday. Stay tuned....
