Week 6 was extremely abbreviated due to the weather. The legislature shut down entirely on Thursday and was "pro forma" on Friday, which means there is virtually no action. There was still activity of note, however.

Our efforts continue on SB 54, the update to the licensure statutes under the Board of Technical Professions (BOTP). We continue to work with KSPE and the BOTP to move this legislation forward without it being burdened by dangerous amendments. As we reported last week, there are efforts to attach very far reaching exceptions to the bill regarding when a licensed professional designer is required. We are gathering data to rebut these bad amendments and engaging in continued conversations with leaders of the Senate. At this point, we don't know when or what the next action will be.

There were two new bills of interest this week. SB 209 would require the public disclosure of an extremely large amount of data submitted as part of any response to solicitations for public contracts over \$100,000. It's not entirely certain yet if the language applies only to bids for construction or also to professional services. If it's the former, it's a bad bill. If it's the latter, it's an awful bill and we will be heavily engaged in trying to kill it. No hearings are scheduled at this time.

HB 2366 would require the state *not* to use any funds for programs that involve sustainable development. This is a brand new bill and we're not sure yet who is behind it. It's an unusual policy proposal...no hearings are scheduled at this time.

HB 2246, which provides liability relief for firms or individuals involved in peer review on design efforts, had a hearing Wednesday in the House Commerce Committee. ACEC Kansas testified in support of the bill. The only opponent was the Board of Technical Professions. They don't oppose the protection from liability, but rather some of the specifics about authority that is granted to the peer review panels. It is likely that a satisfactory compromise will be reached.

Next Tuesday there will be a hearing in the Senate Commerce Committee on SB 179. This is the bill that would require state contracts to be awarded only if at least 70% of the workers on the project are residents of Kansas. We led the fight to kill a similar bill last year, and we will testify in opposition to this bill as well.

The Senate is expected to consider the Governor's tax plan next week....any resulting negative changes to state revenue will mean infrastructure funding will be at risk as they scramble to plug the hole. This will be a key and ongoing development that will probably not be resolved until the end of the session.
