Week three brought our first piece of great news from the 2014 Session! SB 54, our much reported legislation that updates the licensure and scope of practice statutes governing the Kansas Board of Technical Professions, had a hearing in the Senate Federal and State Affairs Committee Wednesday. After the hearing, the committee voted to move the bill out with a favorable recommendation to the full Senate. It was passed with a voice vote, and we were not able to detect anybody voting against the bill. It appeared to be unanimous.

The next step is action by the full Senate. It remains to be seen when this will happen, but it could conceivably be as early as next week. As we have mentioned before, we are anticipating at least one amendment that would provide broad exemptions to scenarios where a licensed designer is required on public buildings. We have been working and visiting with members of the Senate all summer and fall about the possible amendments, and if you have not yet visited with your Senator, we would strongly urge you to do so now. Let them know that you support passage of SB 54 in its current form, and you strongly oppose any amendments to create exemptions to existing licensure requirements. Another round of sincere thanks to those of you that have already made those calls and reported back to us.

The Governor's budget has been presented to the Legislature, but they have not yet begun the true work of fine tuning his proposal. As we have reported previously, there is a cat-and-mouse game underway between the Kansas Supreme Court and the Kansas Legislature as the court ponders its decision in the *Gannon* case, which could potentially require the legislature to come up with hundreds of millions of extra dollars to finance K-12 education.

The pace will continue to quicken next week. Stay tuned...
