LEGISLATIVE NEWSLETTER

ACEC of Kansas No. 9 – March 13, 2015

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Week nine saw the legislature turn most of its attention to a debate about the future of K-12 funding. That notwithstanding, there was a large amount of activity on ACEC Kansas issues.

We continue to push hard for passage of SB 24, which makes small amendments to last year's comprehensive updates to the statutes governing the Board of Technical Professions. There was a hearing in the House Federal and State Affairs Committee this week. Rick Worrel, ACEC Kansas President, testified in support of the bill. KSPE and the associations representing the other four disciplines under the Board of Technical Professions testified in support as well. Unlike the hearings on in the Senate, this time there was opposition. Three individual architects shared their concerns with the State of Kansas licensure law. Interestingly enough, none of them said they were opposed to the modest cleanup language in SB 24, but they are attempting to hijack the bill and use it as a platform for their larger arguments. Somewhat to our surprise, their arguments seem to have found traction with some legislators. We expect the Committee to vote sometime next week, and are working hard to ensure that the bill is passed.

HB 2395, which would raise the threshold below which Regents can use on call contracts, was passed by the House Commerce Committee Wednesday. The bill would raise the threshold for engineering services from \$500,000 to \$1,000,000, and for architecture contracts from \$750,000 to \$1,000,000. Jarrod Mann testified on behalf of ACEC Kansas in support of the bill last week. The bill initially included additional language about the posting of projects and public hearings, but that language was amended out of the bill, leaving just the change to the threshold. With this change, the bill was passed by the Committee Thursday and will hopefully be worked on the Senate floor early next week.

House bills 2177 (Kansas Voluntary Cleanup Fund), 2192 (creating environmental steward fund), and 2193 (creating a risk management program under the Kansas Voluntary Cleanup Fund) were heard this week in the Senate Natural Resources Committee. Pat Goeke submitted testimony in support of HB 2177 and HB 2192. There were no opponents at the hearings, but the Committee had some questions about HB 2192. We are hoping the Committee will discuss and pass these bills early next week.

Introduction of new bills slows down to a crawl at this point in the session, but we have a substantive new bill that just hit the calendar. HB 2407 would enable the state in some circumstances to explore public/private partnerships on state infrastructure projects. We are investigating to find out who requested introduction of this bill and exactly what the implications would be. There are no hearings schedule at this time.

Next week is the last week scheduled for committee hearings. After that, action will move to the floor of each chamber and conference committees. Stay tuned....
