Week 6 was very active at the Capitol on general issues, but pretty light on ACEC activity. The legislature has amended the schedule for the session. Tuesday will now be "turnaround", the day by which most bills (except for a few in exempt committees) have to be successfully passed by the chamber in which they originated or be dead for the session. This means committee activity really ended yesterday. Monday and Tuesday the chambers will be debating bills on the floor.

The biggest news of the week was the House-Senate conference committee reaching agreement on budget updates for the balance of the fiscal year. That is now on its way to the Governor's desk. There was no direct action taken in this budget in reaction to the recent *Gannon* decision on school funding. That decision is probably the biggest unknown hanging over the balance of the 2016 session.

The recommendations from the Alvarez & Marsal (A&M) state efficiency study that we have reported on the last several weeks finally started to be discussed in detail this week. The A&M team made their presentations on the two most troubling recommendations (doing away with the state QBS law and adding more public sector engineers under the guise of doing work cheaper and more efficiently that the private sector) to the House Public & Transportation Budget Safety Committee. The Representatives on the Committee seemed skeptical of the claim that adding more engineers to state agencies would produce cheaper and more efficient work. The subject of QBS was not discussed as part of their report.

ACEC will testify to the same committee on these issues on March 2, the first day back from the turnaround break. We are looking forward to an opportunity to share information and provide data to policy makers on the perils of these two recommendations.

Next week will be short, likely with no significant action on ACEC items.
