Week 10 was relatively slow on ACEC issues, while issues of budget, tax, and school finance heated up considerably.

One ACEC priority was scuttled this week, at least temporarily. ACEC had testified in favor of SB 167, which would remove the need for a local election each time local property taxes increased by more than the rate of inflation. During committee debate on that bill Thursday, an amendment was brought which removed all the original contents of SB 167 and inserted new language regarding property appraisers. This is extremely disappointing, but unfortunately it is part of the process and not that uncommon. We will have conversations with legislative leaders to see if there is a way to resuscitate the original SB 167 and move it forward this year.

Another bill dealing with the need for local elections, HB 2376, is still alive in the House. It is not as helpful as SB 167, but we hear there may be amendments coming which could improve the bill. We will have to wait and see.

It looks like water funding may be stalled for 2017. HB 2241, the most likely vehicle for a new water funding package, is stalled in the House Water Committee and looks like it has run out of momentum.

There was a hearing Thursday on HB 2382, which would increase gas tax by \$.11. You might recall ACEC testified in support of a \$.05 gas tax increase last week in SB 224. ACEC remained neutral this week. This \$.11 increase is not likely to pass, and probably not a good use of political capital with so many other issues underway.

One new bill of interest this week was HB 2389, which has to do with safety and inspection requirements for water and amusement parks. This is a reaction to last year's tragic water slide accident at Schlitterbahn. Among other requirements, it mentions the need for a licensed engineer. KSPE has taken the lead on this, testifying in support of that portion of the bill. There are several pending amendments, and they will probably work the bill sometime next week.

Next week the Legislature will spend almost all their time debating bills on the floor of each chamber. The following week will be full of conference committees, leading up to a scheduled First Adjournment date of April 7. Stay tuned...
