Week 1 was relatively quiet at the Capitol. The Legislature wrapped up its work Thursday night and headed for home. The Governor's State of the State revealed some modest goals for 2018, but the Legislature is still waiting to confirm who will be in the Governor's seat to partner with on issues in 2018. Governor Brownback has been re-nominated for a federal position by President Trump, but it is anyone's guess if/when the US Senate will vote to confirm his appointment.

The K-12 funding issue stemming from the recent *Gannon* decision from the Kansas Supreme Court is already dominating most of the Legislature's attention. We are hopeful continued efforts by the House Water Committee will yield a plan that produces additional funding for water infrastructure and resources, but they have struggled to reach consensus on "who pays" for the last couple years. It is doubtful that transportation infrastructure will see any infusion of funding in the coming fiscal year.

A couple new bills of potential interest have already been introduced. HB 2447 mandates an access point on US Highway 36. We are doing some additional investigating, but generally have concern when such decisions are made by statute instead of licensed professionals. KSPE is monitoring this issue as well. HB 2463 deals with the approval of new construction for the Lansing Correctional Facility, altering the lines of authority regarding what is required for final approval. We'll keep an eye on both.

Next Tuesday Economic Lifelines is hosting a Day at the Capitol in support of transportation. ACEC is a gold sponsor and will be well represented at this event.

The Legislature will take Monday off in observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr holiday and come back on Tuesday. Stay tuned...
