The legislature is gathering steam as they work towards "turnaround", the day by which most bills must be passed by the chamber in which they originated or be dead for the year. Turnaround this year is February 22. Committees will spend most of next week debating and passing bills, with the following week dedicated to action by the full chambers. Consequently, with the exception of a few bills that are in "exempt" committees, most bills will have to be successfully passed by committees by the end of next week or they will be dead.

Governor Colyer gave a much-anticipated speech to the legislature, an "updated state of the state". There were no real surprises in his comments, nor any sharp breaks from the prior administration on policies or priorities. Still, the Legislature seems very receptive to a good working relationship with the new Governor.

ACEC saw one extremely positive development this week. Sub for SB 285, which creates a new task force to study transportation infrastructure needs, funding challenges, and possible solutions, passed the full Senate Thursday on a vote of 33-5. ACEC Kansas is one of the stakeholder groups with a seat on the commission designated for their representatives. Several amendments were made adjusting the makeup of the committee prior to passage, but none that were controversial. There was a motion on the floor of the Senate to send the bill back to committee for more study, but that was easily defeated. The bill now heads to the House where ACEC Kansas will once again offer supporting testimony.

There was a small amount of activity on some water bills this week, but nothing of large consequence.
