ACEC of Kansas No. 7 February 23, 2018

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The Legislature wrapped up its work Thursday night at the "turnaround" deadline and will head home for a five-day weekend. They are scheduled to return Wednesday. Turnaround is the deadline by which most legislation has to be passed in its chamber of origin or be dead for the session. Some committees (tax, budget, fed & state) are exempt from these deadlines.

While each chamber passed a substantial amount of legislation, it was a pretty light agenda in terms of items of interest to ACEC. Funding and budget issues remain at a standstill until the legislature decides how to address the K-12 funding issue as mandated by the Kansas Supreme Court in the *Gannon* decision. An expert hired by the state to bring suggestions of how the Supreme Court directive can be met will offer her first report Friday, and a large number of legislators stayed in town Thursday night to hear that first report. Other state funding and investment decisions are likely to remain in limbo until the school funding piece is decided.

Several water bills of interest, including bills setting up a Kansas water law study commission and creating a state water plan fund & economic development initiatives fund, died for failure to move through their chamber of origin Thursday. As we have remarked in the past, the last two years have seen a good amount of study and effort on water issues from the House Water & Environment Committee, but a consensus on how to address water funding issues has remained elusive.
