ACEC of Kansas No. 8 March 2, 2018

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The legislature came back Wednesday for a very abbreviated week. They are "pro forma" Friday, meaning there is no real activity, so it was a two-day work week.

With that short week, there is not much activity to report, but there was one fairly intense conversation regarding transportation funding in the next fiscal year. House Transportation and Public Safety Budget Committee Chairman JR Claeys made a presentation of his committee's recommendations to the full House Appropriations Committee Thursday. Among these recommendations were taking three education items currently funded by transfers from the state highway fund and funding those items instead from the state general fund. This would result in just over \$100 million that the Governor's budget proposed sweeping from the state highway fund actually remaining in the state highway fund. There was vigorous debate amongst the House Appropriations Committee members, so much so that they were not able to reach resolution and will take the discussion up again Monday. Chairman Claeys made an impassioned presentation about the damage sweeps from the state highway fund have caused and the need to keep this roughly \$100 million in the fund for use on infrastructure. It will be interesting to see where the full committee lands on this decision.

SB 285, setting up a task force to study and make recommendations on the next transportation fund, has not yet been scheduled for a hearing in House Transportation.

They will be back in for a full week of committee work next week. Stay tuned...
