

MINUTES

DECEMBER 9, 2013

Present were Trudy Aron, Gary Nevius, Jerry Nachtrab, Jarrod Mann, Randy Riveland, Frank Burnam, Randy DeShon, Brad Austin, John Krudwig, and Scott Heidner.

Nevius called the meeting to order, and introductions were made. Nevius has changed the name of his firm to Momenta.

It was moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the August 19, 2013 partnering meeting. Motion carried.

Burnam said OFPM is looking for another code review architect to add to their team. The listing closes in late January, and he encouraged those present to pass the word to potential applicants. They have been doing campus visits to take review staff to meet design staff and project managers and procurement officials. He hopes to continue these visits on a regular basis moving forward. They are considering adoption of the 2012 family of codes and are working with the Fire Marshal and other stakeholders to go through the changes that will result. The SBAC meets Wednesday to discuss a couple of projects. The day after Christmas, there will be two new projects headed to the Kansas Register.

KSU did an interview on campus where students were encouraged to attend. Student numbers were not strong at the meeting.

Heidner and Aron led a discussion of possible legislation in 2014, which included licensure law changes in SB 54, state OSHA, and various funding issues.

DeShon gave an update from the Fire Marshal's office. He is the new Field Supervisor for the Eastern part of the state and a job posting is out for a position for a position over the Western half of the state.

Heidner reported on discussions that are ongoing on a possible partnering conference with ACEC, AIA, and AGC.

Brad Austin will be the new chair and John Krudwig will be the new Vice Chair.

The next meeting was set for Monday, March 3 at the ACEC Kansas office.
