

MINUTES
ACEC/AIA/OFPM/OSFM PARTNERING
MARCH 3, 2014
TOPEKA, KANSAS

Present were John Krudwig, Randy Riveland, Frank Burnam, Jerry Nachtrab, Brad Austin, Rod Oathout, and Scott Heidner.

Austin called the meeting to order and introductions were made.

It was moved and seconded to approve the minutes of the December 9, 2013 meeting. Motion carried.

Burnam and Riveland gave the OFPM update. They are still searching for an additional code review architect. They hired a fifth inspector who will be based out of Wichita and will help cover south central Kansas. They are working closely with procurement to determine deadlines for 2014 projects. The SBAC meets next Wednesday and will short list four projects. One of the projects (KSU chiller) will be construction manager at risk. There will be a public hearing in April for approval of that procurement method. They are still in the process of purchasing 2012 codes and setting up training.

Heidner and Humphrey led a discussion of legislative issues, including licensure updates, Regents legislation, peer review liability changes, and budget discussions.

Humphrey led a discussion of a possible partnering conference between ACEC, AIA, and AGC.

It was agreed the next meeting would be June 2 at 3:00 at the ACEC office.
